7. REPORT FROM COMMUNITY POLICE OFFICER: The Clerk had been advised that Sian Summers is no longer our PCSO. His (temporary) replacement will be PCSO Angela Stone. She has just taken over the Peterston super Ely Ward as a caretaker PCSO until further officers are available in addition to her existing Wards of St Brides & Llandow/Ewenny. She has 10 Community Council meetings per month with the three Wards and it is therefore difficult for her to attend them all. She advised that there were no reported crimes in this parish for the last month.

REPORT FROM VALE COUNCILLOR MORGAN: Cllr Morgan advised that he would be touring the area with representatives from the Vale Council looking at possible sites for the Council's Local Housing Plan (affordable housing). He will also visit Swansea's "Tip Treasure" a Re-use Shop at Llansamlet Recycling Centre. Swansea Council has been running this shop for a number of years and was one of the first in the Country to develop such a scheme. Since then it has helped divert thousands of items away from landfill and enables plenty of residents to find a bargain. It is hoped the Vale Council will consider adopting this scheme

15. ROAD ISSUES:

(a) J34/M4 Link Road: The following response had been received from the Vale Council: "As you know the public consultation of the initial WelTAG Stage Two report resulted in an additional recommendation. Arcadis Consultants have since been looking at the feasibility and design of improvements to the existing road. We have just agreed for some additional traffic surveys to be undertaken which will be the final stage of work that will inform the report. Arcadis will then finalise a draft WelTAG Stage Two Plus report which will be considered by the review group for the scheme (which includes community council members and other transport professionals/stakeholders).

Following the review group we will follow the same process as we followed for the initial Stage Two report and it will be reported to our Cabinet and relevant scrutiny committees – at this point the report will be released to the public.

Due to the nature of the study a number of additional tasks have been required, hence the delay in getting a completed Stage Two Plus report. The additional surveys are due to be completed this month and it is envisaged Arcadis getting a draft report to us early/mid-March. Invitation to the review group will then be sent out to you"

(b) Tredodridge Speed Issues: An update in this respect is awaited SP

(c) Road signage J34/M4: Jane Hutt AM has been requested to chase Ken Skates AM as to when the agreed works will commence JR
