

**PENDOYLAN COMMUNITY COUNCIL
CYNGOR CYMUNED PENDEULWYN**

A Meeting of Pendoylan Community Council took place at 8 pm on Thursday 11 November 2021 via Zoom

1. PRESENT: Cllr R Rees (Chair) Cllrs J Huddart, G Kellen, E Carson and Vale Councillor M Morgan and J Roberts (Clerk).

2. APOLOGIES: Cllrs J Williams & H Hanmer

3. MINUTES: The Minutes of the meeting held on 14 October 2021 had been previously circulated and were approved

4. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST: None

5. MATTERS ARISING:

(a) Benches:

- The benches have been installed on the village green and at Clawdd Coch. Thanks were expressed to John Hanmer in this respect. It was agreed a commemorative plaque be affixed to the bench on the green – suitable wording to be agreed **JR/ALL**
- The Clerk advised that the bench in the field behind Tredodridge is rotten and dangerous. It was agreed this should be removed and it was suggested it be ascertained whether John Hanmer could assist in this respect. **JR/HH**

(b) Playpark: Volunteers to paint the mini roundabout have been received for when the weather improves in, say, Spring 2022. The Vale Council will be advised accordingly and a request for the paint, brushes etc. made nearer that time. Meanwhile the Vale Council have received grant monies from the Welsh Government for playpark improvements and it was agreed an application be made in this respect prior to the deadline 31 March 2022 **ALL**

Thanks were extended to Cllr Rob Rees for cutting the playpark hedge

(c) Clawdd Coch Noticeboard: H Hanmer to advise whether any of the young Chapel members are willing to carry out the noticeboard treatment **HH**

(d) Culvert Fencing: E Carson stated that he had obtained a quote for the fencing repair but this requires some clarification before acceptance **EC**

6. REPORT FROM COMMUNITY POLICE OFFICER: PCSO Richard Davies had advised there had been no reported crimes in the parish during October 2021

7. REPORT FROM VALE COUNCILLOR MORGAN:

(a) Police – Non Attendance at Meetings: Cllr Morgan will again raise the issue of non-attendance of Police at Community Council Meetings with the Chief Inspector. **MM**

(b) Rural Road Policy – Cllr Morgan referred to Ewenny's request for a specific rural road policy which was the subject of a special Community Liaison Committee Meeting on 4 November 2021.

The Cabinet Member for Neighbourhood Services and Transport noted the request for a specific Rural Roads Policy for the Vale of Glamorgan area be considered. Unfortunately Councillor King was not convinced of the benefit of such a policy and believed that existing policies adequately covered the matter. The Leader added that many of the issues discussed were issues that could be attributed to many roads in the Vale of Glamorgan, not just rural areas, e.g., speeding, use of rat runs, etc. Some rural roads were set as national speed limits and not a matter for the Council to address.

Cllr Morgan was not satisfied with this response and has asked that the matter be placed on a future agenda of the Environment and Regeneration Scrutiny Committee meeting for further consideration. **MM**

(c) Brown Signage on A48: Cllr Morgan believes that signage to indicate pubs & other local amenities is important for our communities but the Vale Council have said they have no funds available for more signs. However, Cllr Morgan will pursue this **MM**

(d) Draft Replacement LDP Delivery Agreement Consultation: He was pleased to note that this it is proposed that any future development should include provision for housing for the elderly. He urged everyone to read this and respond by 17 December 2021 to the Consultation accessed via

8. PLANNING:

(a) The following applications have been received:

- An amended Application for the erection of 3 yurts at Hillside, Pendoylan. It was agreed to reiterate the objections made by the Community Council to the original application and request the Local Authority to ensure all nearby residents are notified **JR**
- An amended Application for a 2 storey side & rear extension at Cross House, Clawdd Coch, Pendoylan. It was agreed to reaffirm that the Community Council had no objection to this Application **JR**

(b) The Application for disabled toilets at Pendoylan War Memorial Hall, Pendoylan had been approved

(c) Proposed diversion of Public Footpath No. 26 Trehedyn. A response had been received from the Vale Council's Right of Way Officer advising that to date no agreement had been reached between the 2 parties and setting out instructions as to the next steps that could be taken by the objecting party. This has been forwarded to Linda James for her information and it was felt that the Community Council was not in a position to offer any further assistance

The Remembrance "Tommy" has been sited on the bank opposite the Red Lion Pub

15. CHRISTMAS EVENT: Disappointingly no suggestions as to the format for this event have been received via the Community Council's Noticeboard. However, Fr David had suggested Carol Singing around the tree on the village green or in the Red Lion. If no further suggestions received it was suggested Fr David might be approached to arrange this. It was agreed not to pursue the idea of a tea party in the village hall in view of the increase in Covid infections. In any event it was agreed a meeting is required to discuss other aspects of this event i.e. catering etc on 17 November 2021 at 7 pm via zoom GK
With regard to the **tree lights** it was agreed these should be put up the weekend of 27/28 November. E Carson has the lights and it is hoped Jason Welsh can assist him and J Williams in this respect EC/JW

16. HYBRID MEETINGS: OVW have invited Community Councils to complete a survey as to their views regarding the proposed Welsh Government's ruling that multi-location meetings must be provided. The survey questions were discussed and responses agreed JR
